Digger Stanley (Fulham)

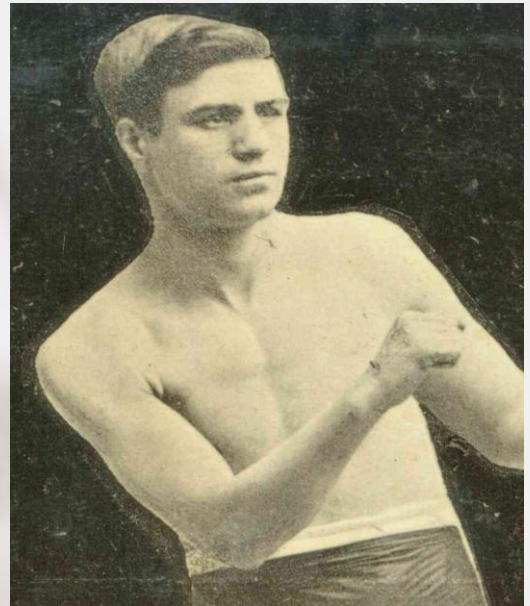
Active: 1904-1918
